Enforces it





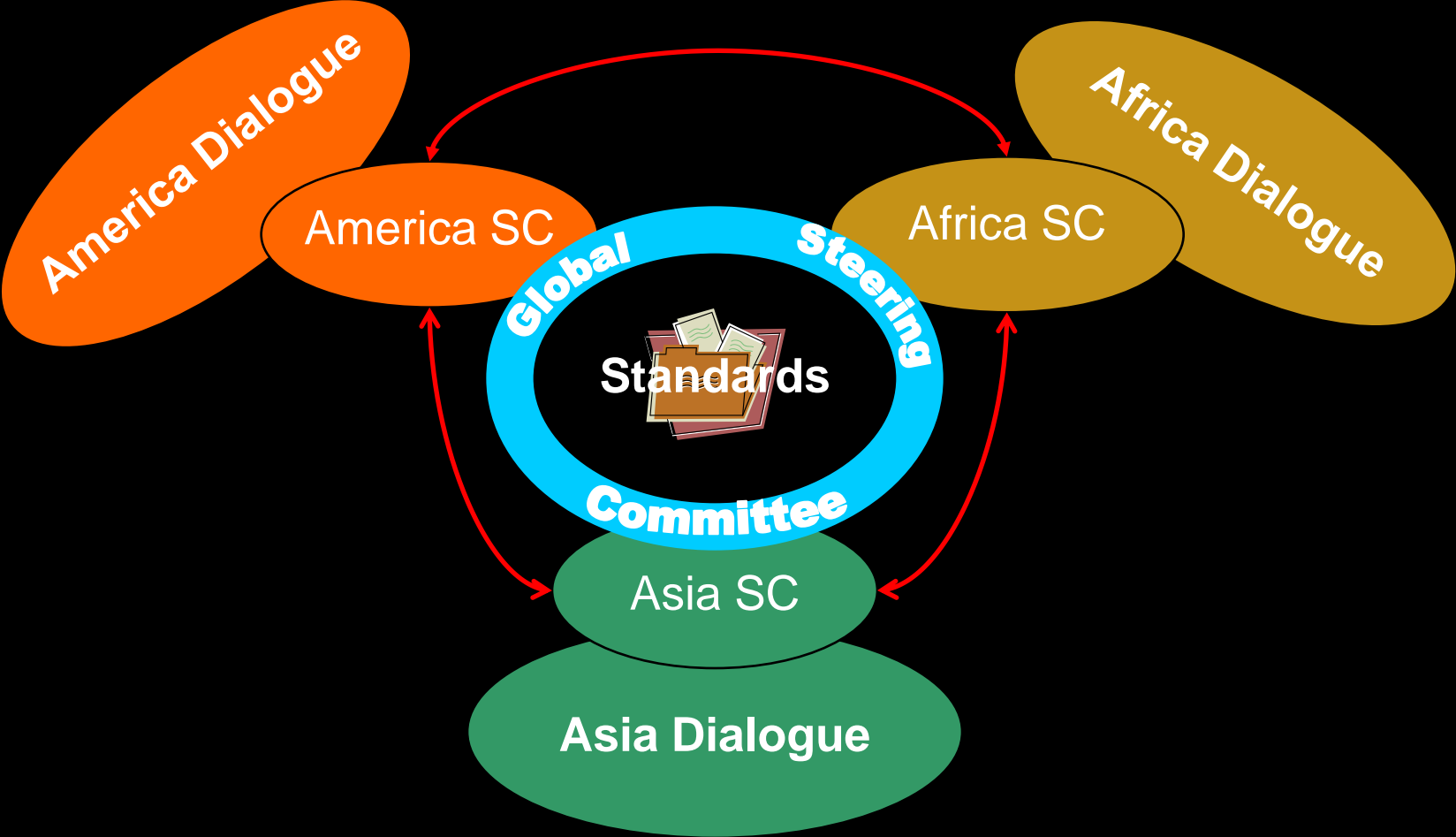
# Who serves on the steering committee?
