PULP AND PAPER IS ONE OF WWF'S 15 PRIORITY COMMODITIES, AS UNSUSTAINABLE AND ILLEGAL LOGGING TO MEET GLOBAL DEMAND FOR INEXPENSIVE PAPER PRODUCTS HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACTED THE PLACES AND SPECIES WWF SEEK TO PROTECT, LIKE THE ISLANDS OF BORNEO AND SUMATRA.

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* RELIGIOUS LEADERS IN AFRICA COMMIT TO STOPPING WILDLIFE CRIME

FIFTY RELIGIOUS LEADERS FROM AFRICA CALLED FOR THE END OF THE ILLEGAL WILDLIFE TRADE IN AFRICA - A CONTINENT THAT IS EXPERIENCING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF WILDLIFE KILLINGS IN MORE THAN 20 YEARS. WWF ANNOUNCED THE FIRST-EVER PARTNERSHIP WITH FAITH LEADERS FROM ACROSS AFRICA, FOLLOWING A WWF-LED WILDLIFE SAFARI IN NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK IN SEPTEMBER. DURING THE SAFARI, RELIGIOUS LEADERS DISCUSSED THE ROLE OF RELIGION IN AFRICA TO HALT THE TRADE.

* MEXICAN GOVERNMENT TAKES ACTION TO PROTECT VAQUITAS

IN JUNE, THE MEXICAN GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED IT WOULD BAN THE USE OF GILLNETS IN THE UPPER GULF OF CALIFORNIA AND START USING FISHING GEAR THAT IS SAFER FOR THE VAQUITA, THE WORLD'S SMALLEST PORPOISE. THIS DECISION CAME AFTER WWF ORGANIZED A GLOBAL PETITION AROUND THE ISSUE, WHICH RECEIVED MORE THAN 38,000 SIGNATURES FROM 127 COUNTRIES. WWF WILL WORK TO HELP TRAIN FISHERMEN TO USE THE NEW, VAQUITA-FRIENDLY NETS.

* BIG WINS FOR MARINE SPECIES - SHARKS AND MANTA RAYS - AT CITES

IN MARCH, AT THE CITES MEETING, GOVERNMENT AGENCIES VOTED TO REGULATE THE TRADE OF SEVERAL SPECIES OF SHARKS AND MANTA RAYS. THIS WILL HELP HALT THE UNCONTROLLED TRADE THAT HAS LED TO THEIR DECLINE.

* THROUGH THE EARTH HOUR CITY CHALLENGE, CITIES BECOME ADVOCATES FOR CLIMATE CHANGE

THE FIRST YEAR OF THE EARTH HOUR CITY CHALLENGE WAS A MAJOR SUCCESS. TWENTY-NINE U.S. COMMUNITIES JOINED THE CHALLENGE, REPRESENTING MORE THAN 11 MILLION AMERICANS. WWF WORKED CLOSELY WITH SAN FRANCISCO,
