STANDARDS DRAFTING	
2009, January-February	Key stakeholders meet by phone to lay groundwork for SCAD. SCAD stakeholder network developed through communications and outreach.
2009, February 18-19	SCAD 1 dialogue is held in Seattle, just after Aquaculture America, with 43 participants from industry, NGOs and science/academics. SCAD Steering Committee (SC) is selected by participants.
2009, September 24-25	SCAD 2 dialogue is held in Veracruz, just after WAS, with 28 participants from industry, NGOs and science/academics. Additional SC members are selected by participants.
2009, September 25	SC meets in Veracruz.
2010, March 6	Outreach workshop convened in San Diego, just after Aquaculture 2010, with 16 participants from industry, NGOs and science/academics.
2010, May-September	SC meets by phone to work on draft Principles and Criteria.
2010, September - 2011, June	SC meets by phone to work on draft Principles, Criteria and Indicators and Standards.
PUBLIC CONSULTATION	
2011, June 10	Draft SCAD standards released for first public consultation period (60 days).
2011, June 10-11	SCAD 3 dialogue at WAS 2011 is held to review the draft standards as part of public consultation.
2011, August 10	First public consultation period for the draft standards closes.
2011, August - September	SC meets to review comments received and to make changes to the standards. Draft SCAD standards revised based on comments from first 60 day public consultation period.
2011, September	Summary of the SC meeting is posted that includes key decisions made regarding amendments to the standards and dissenting opinions.
2011, October 1	Revised draft SCAD standards released for second public consultation period (30 days).
2011, October 30	Second public consultation period for the draft standards closes.
FINALIZATION	
2011, November	SC meets by phone to review comments received and to make changes to the standards. Draft SCAD standards revised based on comments from second 60 day public consultation period. Summary of the SC meeting is posted that includes key decisions made regarding amendments to the standards and dissenting opinions.
2011, December	SCAD Environmental and Social Standards published and made publicly available.
